## Definitions, disability and impairments



#### **Definitions**

**Inclusive design** and **accessible design** are closely related, but they're not the same thing.

 Inclusive design is a way to approach a design project, rather than an outcome. It's a process to help provide a user-friendly experience for people of all backgrounds and abilities.





#### **Definitions**

 Accessible design focuses on the end result of a project. It aims to make sure people with different disabilities can benefit from your work, and often concentrates on a specific set of user needs.







# When you design with accessibility in mind, you design for everyone

#### The social model of disability

The understanding that disability is something created by society.

Impairments don't necessarily prevent people from participating in society.

Instead, they are excluded because of attitudes, environments, policies and practices.


#### Why is this important?






#### Why is this important?
